It was originally planned to last two years, but the pandemic has messed things up and extended the timeframe. Fortunately, we were granted a 6month extension that allowed us to complete the activities planned in the proposal. The last months of the project have been full of events, starting last spring with the realisation of the pilot courses in the 4 partner countries, followed by the International Workshop on 7 and 8 October 2021 and the International Conference held on Wednesday 16 February 2022. One aspect that all these activities, meetings and events have had in common is the fact that they have carried out online, in the most diverse platforms. While on the one hand the Covid 19 pandemic has resulted in the cancellation of many international trips, on the other hand it has encouraged to use some online tools that were previously used little or not at all. If it is undeniable that face-to-face meetings have a unique intensity and involvement, the possibility of saving money and reducing environmental impact by using online meetings is certainly a new and revolutionary aspect. Perhaps the key lies in finding a balance between the two alternatives.






PILOT COURSES






